

## Mitchell/Tufts Foundation Scholarship

**Background:** The Mitchell/Tufts Foundation Scholarship was established at The Dallas Foundation in 2014. The goal of the Fund is to make a college degree or vocational certification possible for members or persons active in the life of a Presbyterian church in the Presbyterian Church USA (PCUSA) in Los Angeles, California, and its surrounding communities, who are students of promise and can demonstrate financial need.

**Amount:** \$1,000.00 - \$5,000.00

**Funds to be used for:** Tuition, fees and books

**Geographic limitations:** City of Los Angeles, and its surrounding communities

**Eligibility:** Applicants must

- Be an active member or active in the life of a Presbyterian church in the Presbyterian Church USA, in the City of Los Angeles, and its surrounding communities
- Be accepted for enrollment or are currently enrolled in a two- or four-year undergraduate program in an accredited college, university, vocational school or trade school
- demonstrate financial need
- have work experience and/or community service experience

**Preference may be given to:**

Active members or persons active in the life of Westminster Presbyterian Church, Los Angeles

*A Student of Promise:* A Student of Promise may not be a 4.0 student, a star athlete or the most well-known student on campus, but considering some of the events in their lives, they are doing a tremendous job keeping that "C" average and maintaining a good attendance record.

*A Middle Class Student:* A Middle Class student may come from a family with incomes too high to qualify for existing financial aid programs, but still unable to afford the fees without relying heavily on student loans.

**Deadline:** **May 10, 2018**

**Renewals:** Renewals are not automatic, but past recipients are encouraged to reapply each year
